

FAIRVIEW BAPTIST CHURCH
Guidelines in Selecting and Awarding
The Rufus W. Pearson Scholarship

A copy of these guidelines shall be attached to the endowment agreement existing between Fairview Baptist Church and the North Carolina Baptist Foundation, Inc. and a copy shall be provided each prospective applicant.

I. APPLICANTS

1. Shall be members of the Fairview Baptist Church, 2531 Flat Rock Road, Reidsville, NC 27320.
2. Must be seeking training beyond the high school level.
3. Application will and must be filed by the applicant not later than June 1 for fall semester, October 1 for spring semester, of each year to the Fairview Baptist Church Scholarship Committee.

II. RECIPIENT

1. Shall have a need for financial assistance.
2. Shall have met entrance requirements and is accepted by an accredited post secondary institution (college, university, technical/community college).
3. Exhibits high moral character, dedication to family, church and community.

III. GRANTS

1. Shall be awarded on a semester basis, subject to review and re-submission of application before being continued in subsequent semester.
2. May be awarded to one or more eligible recipients, at the discretion of the committee, and in amounts determined solely by the committee.
3. Will be paid to school of choice and not to recipient, but may be delivered to recipient for him/her to deposit with school.
4. Recipient(s) shall be announced to the church during its July business meeting and the January business meeting by the Fairview Baptist Church Scholarship Committee
5. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to make no grant in any one year should there be no applicant who, in the opinion of the Committee, qualifies according to all of the requirements of these guidelines. In such event the Committee will advise the North Carolina Foundation to direct that the amount available for awards in any one year be added to the endowment corpus.
6. In the event that Fairview Baptist Church ceases to exist, the Dan Valley Missionary Baptist Association, in accord with the North Carolina Baptist Foundation, shall select and designate worthy beneficiaries of the Scholarship, so that the funds will continue to carry out as near as possible, the purposes of the church.
